1 RULES

1.1* The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Sandpiper, Auxiliary and HobieCat/Multihull classes.

3 CLASSIFICATION

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

5 FEES

8 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on **06/22/08** after **10:00am**

10 VENUE

10.1 Kettle Creek – North Barnegat Bay Sailing Area

11 THE COURSES

The diagrams in the addendum* show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 For the all classes rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

12.3 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

13 SCORING

13.1 The Bonus Point System of Appendix A will apply.

14 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boat shall be marked with SAYC club abbreviation

15 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places on SAYC property

16 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

17 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

18 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
