1 RULES

1.1* The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of any class with a PHRF rating.

3 CLASSIFICATION

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

5 FEES

5.1 Required fees are as follows:

6 QUALIFYING SERIES

The regatta will consist of a qualifying series. **There will be a skipper's meeting ½ hour before the start of the 1st race for your class.**

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

10 VENUE

10.1 Kettle Creek – North Barnegat Bay Sailing Area

11 THE COURSES

The diagrams in the addendum* show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 For the all classes rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

12.3 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

13 SCORING

13.1 The Bonus Point System of Appendix A will apply.

14 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boat shall be marked with SAYC club abbreviation

15 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places on SAYC property

16 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

17 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall not make radio transmissions while racing but will receive radio communications regarding course by the race committee.

19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
